

SHOEBOX CRAFT

CD Spinning Tops

You'll need:

- Blank or used CD *
- Small marble *
- Bottle cap
- Super glue (E6000)

STEP 1

Use E6000 or similar glue (glue gun is not strong enough to endure heat or cold this "top" may experience in a shoebox). It can be found in most stores in the Craft Section. Glue the cap to one side of the CD – this will be the side that will show while spinning. If you are doing this craft with your kids (VBS, Sunday School, just for fun), glue gun would probably work.

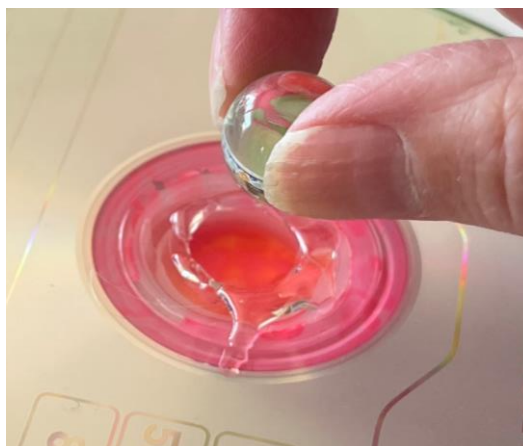
STEP 2

Decorating the "top" is easier before putting the marble on because it lies flat while it's drying. I used a sharpie marker (black) and nail polish (red) on this one. For more decorating ideas, see next page. I waited a few hours to dry before turning it over for the marble.



STEP 3

Using the glue, glue the marble to the "bottom" of the CD. Wipe excess glue and let sit for 24 hrs.





NOTE: The more dynamic the pattern (geo shapes, lines, etc.), the more dramatic the effect. Liquid paint that cannot be sent from craft kits in shoeboxes could be used for this.
