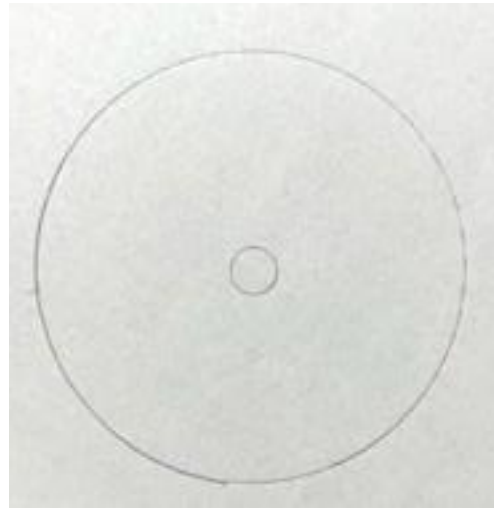
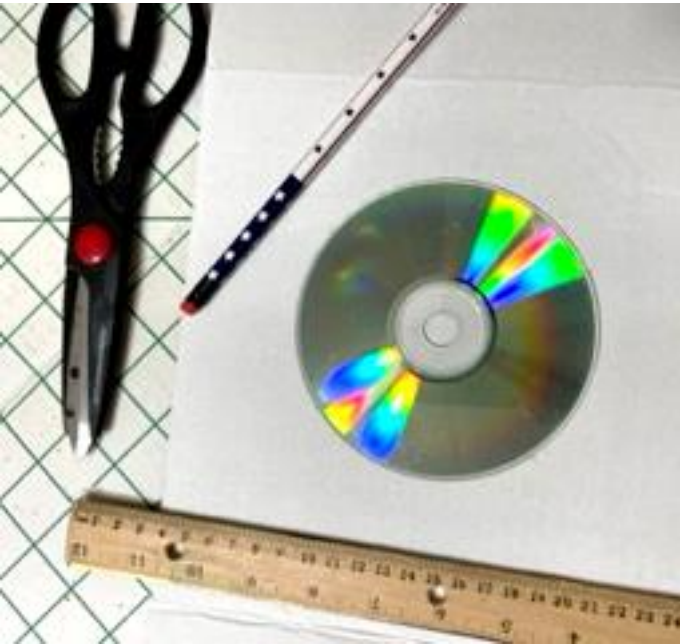


T-shirt 7 string Bracelet or Headband - LOOM

Bracelets or headbands can be made using 7 colors. Works best using single strand (yarn or remnants) of at least 24". You will need to make a "loom" out of cardboard or paper plate. I used a CD to trace a circle and the center hole on to a piece of cardboard. I cut around my circle and punctured the center hole out.



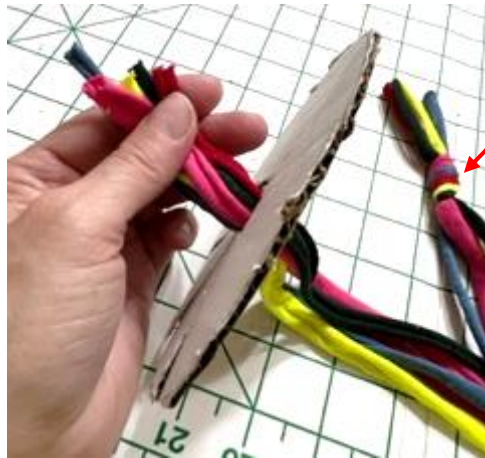
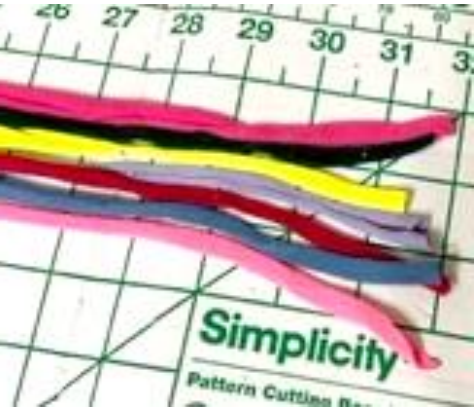
Using a ruler or a straight edge divide the circle into 8 "pie" sections. They do not have to be exact, but you'll want to give yourself room to work.



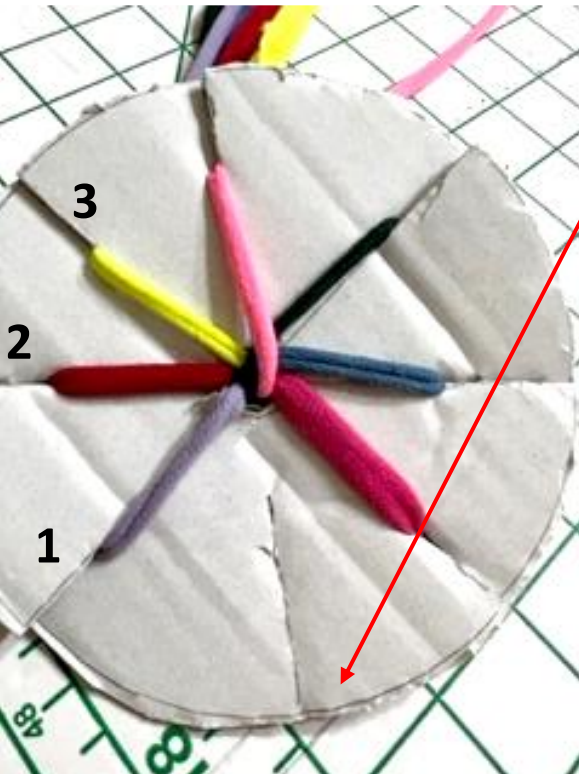
Using scissors, cut halfway towards the center. You should have 8 slots in your loom.

T-shirt 7 string Bracelet or Headband

You'll need 7 long strands of T-shirt yarn. Headbands need longer strands than bracelets, but you'll want them to close in length. In this example, I have chosen 7 different colors of yarn about 36" long.



Tie the ends of the yarn together before pushing the ends through the center hole. Pull until the knot is against the back.



Put one strand in each slot.

Leave one slot open. Position the open slot at the bottom. You will want to keep the empty slot towards you. You may go clockwise or counterclockwise, but you must go in the same direction once you've started.



Example is moving to the right. Counting the first 3 strands (Purple, maroon, and neon yellow), I moved the yellow to the empty slot on the bottom. Then I turned the loom so the empty slot was at the bottom. Next strand I move would be blue. Continue until you reach desired length or run out of any color. Remove from the loom, tie and trim.
